# FRIENDS OF HEMLOCK BLUFFS




The Friends of Hemlock Bluffs is a volunteer based non-profit, support organization created to further the mission, environmental education programs and facilities at Hemlock Bluffs Nature Preserve. Members provide financial support, volunteer assistance and aid in promoting the nature preserve and nature center as valuable community resources.



## HISTORY

In the 1970's, a group formed to protect the land known today as Hemlock Bluffs Nature Preserve. With lots of hard work, the Hemlock Bluffs Preservation Society became successful in their plan to protect the nature preserve under State of North Carolina jurisdiction. In 1995, the Cary Woman's Club provided infrastructure and officers to begin creating a new support organization for Hemlock Bluffs and the Nature Center. The founding members of the Hemlock Bluffs *Preservation Society* approached the Cary Woman's Club and suggested they use the original group name and their articles of incorporation since the group had never officially disbanded. Thus, the second use of the name *Hemlock* Bluffs Preservation Society occurred. With consistent help from the Cary Women's Club, exhibits were funded along with resources, equipment, and support for the organization to grow.
